

Great Glasses Play Day Glasses Mask Tutorial

Based on an idea by Amanda at Educators' Spin on it.

What you need:

- 1 craft foam sheet. (5 1/2" x 8 1/2" was the perfect size)
- scissors
- pen
- stickers or markers to decorate

Instructions

1. Place your child's glasses in the center of the foam sheet with the bottom of the frames touching the bottom edge of the sheet. Use the pen to mark where the arms of the glasses meet the lenses on each side (at the hinges).



2. Now trace the top of your child's glasses and the sides, making sure to stay on the inside of the marks you made at the hinges.

When you take the glasses off, you should see something like this:



The two dots are where the hinges are, the outline is a rough shape of the glasses. This is the part you'll cut out for your child to see through.

3. Now draw the shape of the rest of the mask. It could look like ears, or a super hero, or a fancy ball mask. Zoe wanted a butterfly shape. Cut out the mask.



4. Cut small slits where you marked the arms of the glasses.

Make sure not to cut all the way to the bottom of the mask. At the end, you should have something like this:



5. To put the mask on, you slide it on to the glasses.



6. But don't forget to decorate it with markers and stickers!! (it's easiest to do that if you take the mask off the glasses first).
